The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.75 dated 29.05.2007 for the offence under Sections 420/376 IPC registered at Police Station Division No.3, Jalandhar, alongwith all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

The FIR was registered on the statement made by the complainant- Amarjit Kaur that petitioner who was staying on the ground floor and was on annual leave from Indian Navy had developed the relation with his daughter- Rubila and sexually exploited her and on this background, FIR was got registered.

Petitioner is present in Court today and Rubila and her mother Amarjit Kaur also present in Court. On a specific query, Rubila-respondent No.3 states that she is residing with petitioner as his wife and in March, 2016, she has given birth of a girl child. Complainant-Amarjit Kaur states that she is happy with the married life of her daughter-Rubila and she has no objection, if, the FIR is quashed qua the petitioner.

Affidavits qua the petitioner, prosecutrix-Rubila and complainant-

Amarjit Kaur, have been filed in Court today, stating therein that compromise has been effected between the parties and complainant and her daughter have no objection if the FIR is quashed qua the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State has informed the Court that cancellation report had been prepared and it was submitted before the trial Court on 24.10.2015.

Keeping in view the above and considering the fact that prosecutrix Rubila-is now major, FIR No.75 dated 29.05.2007 for the offence under Sections 420/376 IPC registered at Police Station Division No.3, Jalandhar is quashed alongwith all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner.
