The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 19 dated 19.11.2015 under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC registered at Women Police Station Sector 17, Chandigarh

As per report of the Mediator, parties could not reach an amicable settlement and the petitioner has paid litigation expenses of Rs.25,000/- before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court to the complainant.

However, after hearing learned counsel for the parties, order dated 22.12.2015 granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the condition that petitioner will make F.D.R of Rs.5 lakhs, in favour of the complainant and submit it before the trial Court. The decision with regard to release of the above said amount will be seen by the trial Court at the final stage.
