By filing the present petition under Section 439 read with Section 439-A of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in FIR No.160 dated 29.07.2016, registered under Sections 15 and 25 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS Act'), at Police Station Gobindgarh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

It is contended that the petitioner is a patient of permanent colostomy and he was operated upon on 10.02.2017 for fresh colostomy. Earlier, the petitioner was admitted to

interim bail and he did not misuse the concession of same.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, duly acknowledges the factum of surgery and post surgery follow up of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the above, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to interim bail for 12 weeks from the date of his release on his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, concerned. The date to surrender is to be indicated by the releasing Court.

At this stage, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. Prayer allowed.
