LISA GILL, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of bail pending trial in FIR No. 55 dated 30.05.2016 registered under Section 307,498-A,34 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') at Police Station Jaito, District Faridkot.

The above said FIR emanates from matrimonial discord between the petitioner and the complainant i.e. his wife-Smt. Rajni. Matter has since been amicably settled between the parties. It has been decided that the complainant shall start residing at her matrimonial home. This matter was adjourned to 13.02.2017 to enable the learned counsel for the State to verify whether the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties. This case was again adjourned on 22.02.2017 for today on request of learned counsel for the State.

Learned counsel for the State submits that as per information supplied by Station House Officer, Police Station Jaitu, SI Sukhmander Singh, it has been verified that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties. The complainant is yet residing at her parental house at Kotkapura but it has been settled that as and when the petitioner is released

on bail, she shall join him at their matrimonial home.

Learned counsel for the complainant also verifies the above said position.

In view of the facts and circumstances of this case noted above, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner incarcerated any longer. No recovery is to be effected from him. It is considered just and expedient to allow this petition in the peculiar facts of the case.

Consequently, the petitioner shall be released on bail pending trial in case FIR No. 55 dated 30.05.2016 registered under Section 307, 498-A, 34 IPC at Police Station Jaito, District Faridkot subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.

Nothing observed hereinabove shall be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
