The instant petition was preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 11 on account of having entered into matrimonial alliance.

Notice of motion having been issued, State counsel has filed in Court today a response by way of an affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Indri, Karnal. The same is taken on record.

The categoric stand taken in the reply is to the following effect:

“That as soon as the copy of petition and order passed by this Hon'ble Court was received in the premises of Police Station Indri, Karnal SI Prem Chand was directed to enquire the matter and report. As per directions issued to the Enquiry Officer, he has visited the house of the petitioners at their given home address in the petition and statement of Rahisha and Sokat Ali were recorded, who have categorically submitted their statement stated therein that they have

solemnized marriage against the wishes of their parents. She has further stated that she has also five children. After marriage, they have filed the above said petition before the Hon'ble High Court at Chandigarh for seeking the protection against Sokhat Ali's parents and near relatives. They further stated that they have no apprehension of danger to their life from the hands of respondents No.4 to 11 and now they did not want to take any legal action against them

That the Enquiry Officer also visited the hosue of the private respondents namely Naushad S/o Ishak, Nargis W/o Sh. Naushad, Mohammad Hassan S/o Sh. Sadik Mohammad (father of petitioner No.2), Kamil Hassan S/o Sh. Sadik Mohammad (brother of petitioner No.2), Taj Mohammad S/o Sh. Mohammad Hassan (brother of petitioner No.2), Salar Mohammad, Raj Mohammad S/o Sh. Hassan Mohammad, Mohabbat Mohammad (respondents No.4 to 11) all residents of Gurha, Tehsil Indri, District Karnal, who have been categorically stated that the petitioners have solemnized marriage with their own consent and they have no objection qua the marriage of the petitioners.”

In the light of such stand taken on behalf of the State and the statements recorded of the parties concerned, no further directions are required to be passed in the instant petition and the same is, accordingly, disposed of.
