[2]. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Tanuj Sharma, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4. Let copies of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

[3]. In this petition, the petitioner seeks a direction upon the Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to ensure that no further harassment is caused to him and in the event of any criminal complaint actually lodged against him, he may be given adequate notice to the same.

[4]. His allegations are that he is being telephonically threatened by respondent No.5, who is a Constable in the Chandigarh Police at the instigation of private respondent No.6. He has submitted representations in

that regard to the Superintendent of Police, Bijnor, U.P. as well as to the Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh (Annexure P-1 and P-2, respectively), but still intimidation and harassment continues.

[5]. Without adverting to the merits of the petitioner's allegations, the present petition is disposed off with a direction upon respondent No.3 to examine the petitioner's representation (Annexure P-2) and to ensure that adequate notice under Section 160(2) of the Cr.P.C. is given to him in the event of any criminal complaint being filed against him.
