Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.221 dated 16.03.2017 under Sections 302, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Camp Palwal, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR. It is only in the supplementary statement made by Satish, who is stated to be an eye-witness in the case, petitioner has been named. He further states that once the petitioner is not named by complainant-Jagat Singh and the deceased himself, his false implication is duly established. He also submits the fact that there is a reference of three other persons, namely, Rajesh, Raj Kumar and Chhotu (Devender) in the FIR, who belongs to the village of Satish and are his close friends, have not been named by him in the statement made under Section 161 Cr.P.C. is also

On the other hand, learned State Counsel while referring to the statement made by Satish, an eye-witness in the case, recorded under Section 161 Cr.P.C., has stated that in fact the injuries on the person of deceased-Bhagat Singh were given by the petitioner, who had a knife in his hand. There were as many as seven injuries on the person of deceased-Bhagat Singh.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that Bhagat Singh had died because of repeated knife injuries and in the statement recorded under Section 161 Cr.P.C., Satish has specifically named the petitioner, no case for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
