This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.206 dated 19.11.2016, under Sections 420/34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines Bathinda, District Bathinda.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 14.12.2016:-

“Petitioners are two ladies who seek concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Sandeep Bansal alleging that the petitioners had promised him to give IELTS training and settle his clients abroad.

A sum of Rs.50,000/- is alleged to have been repaid out of Rs.3,80,000/- allegedly received by the petitioners.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that loan amount had been given by the petitioners to the complainant through cheque which has been misused to launch false criminal case against the petitioners. It has been claimed that the complainant is a professional rival of petitioner no.1 who

is also running a travel agency.

*Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the
petitioners will join investigation on 24.12.2016 and
14.1.2017. In case of petitioners doing so, they shall be
released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting
officer.”*

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Jaspal Singh
apprises the Court the petitioners have since joined investigation.

Even the observations contained in the notice of motion order
have gone un rebutted.

Prayer made in the instant petition is accepted. Order dated
14.12.2016, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
