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DEEPAK SIBAL, J.(ORAL)

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P. C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.363, dated 18.12.2016, registered under Sections 381, 420, 120-B of IPC, at Police Station Focal Point Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 09.02.2017, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

Seeking the concession of anticipatory bail, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated; as per the interim order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation; no custodial interrogation of the petitioner is necessary; the main allegation in the case is against Ranjit Singh who is alleged to have received the money from the customers of the complainant firm and misappropriated the same and that the extent of the involvement of the petitioner would be deciphered during the course of the trial.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sohan Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and at this stage is not needed by the investigating agency for further questioning.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and order dated 09.02.2017 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions as prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Nothing observed herein above shall be considered to be an expression of opinion by this court on the merits of the case.
