Petitioner Jai Kishan has filed the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 415 dated 28.04.2016, under Sections 304-B, 302, 498-A and 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Rohtak, District Rohtak.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is the father-in-law of the deceased and has been falsely implicated in the case and in fact the deceased was suffering from depression and being treated for it from PGIMS, Rohtak. Counsel for the petitioner further contends that the

petitioner has been in custody since 29.04.2016. The complainant has already been examined and the trial is likely to take some time since 23 witnesses have to be examined.

Mr. Siddharth Sanwaria, DAG, Haryana, appearing on behalf of the respondent-State submits that there is specific allegations against the petitioner in the FIR and there is no adequate ground made out for releasing him on regular bail.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the facts that statement of the complainant has been recorded, the petitioner is in custody since 29.04.2016 and further that the trial is likely to take some time, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody furthermore. Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
