This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.135 dated 09.10.2016, under Sections 306, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station, Kharar, District Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is an employee of Easy Visa Company.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed the Court that as per report dated 25.04.2017 given by the Forensic Science Laboratory, suicide note has been written by the deceased. In the suicide note, it is stated that the employees of the Easy Visa Company have mentally tortured the deceased for about 1½ months by giving false assurances. Learned State counsel has further informed that in compliance with the order dated 14.12.2016, petitioner has joined investigation on 15.01.2017 and she is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the said fact, interim order dated 14.12.2016 passed by

this Court is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
