The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.47 dated 16.07.2016, for the offence under Sections 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Behram, District SBS Nagar along with all subsequent proceedings arising there from on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

The marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with respondent No.2 on 22.02.2011 as per Sikh rites and ceremonies and no child was born out of this wedlock. On account of temperamental differences and misunderstanding, FIR was got registered with the allegations that respondent No.2 had been harassed by her in-laws.

During the pendency of the petition, the matter has now been compromised vide Annexure P-2 and in terms of the compromise, 2 Kanal 10 Marlas of land has been transferred in favour of respondent No.2 vide registered sale deed dated 12.08.2016 and a joint petition for dissolution of

marriage under Section 13-B HMA has been filed (Annexure P-3) on 24.08.2016 and statements of petitioner No.1 and respondent No.2 on the first motion have also been attached with this petition as Annexure P-4 and P-5.

On notice, respondent No.2 has put in appearance in Court today who has been identified by ASI Balvir Singh and she has given her affidavit/reply stating therein that the dispute relating to the said FIR has been amicably settled with the intervention of common friends and relatives vide written compromise (Annexure P-2) and the same is free will without any pressure or fear and she has no objection if the present FIR is quashed qua the petitioners.

Keeping in view the above, FIR No.47 dated 16.07.2016, for the offence under Sections 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Behram, District SBS Nagar is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
