Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.106 dated 27.08.2017 under Sections 307, 326, 325, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Chatiwind, District Amritsar (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the allegation against the petitioner is that he has caused injuries on the person of Luvdavinder Singh on the back of his neck and on his left shoulder, but both injuries are stated to be simple in nature though given with a sharp edged weapon. She further states that pursuant to the order dated 20.11.2017 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Pal Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact that the injuries are simple in nature and

states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 20.11.2017 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
