Petitioners-Satnam Singh, Gursimrat Singh alias Gurjit Singh, Lakhvir Singh, Gurbir Singh, Jagjit Singh and Avtar Singh have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in cross-case in FIR No.08 dated 16.01.2016, registered at Police Station Doraha, Ludhiana, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 326, 34 and 201 of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioners were found innocent

during the investigation and kept in column No.2. Now, they have been summoned under Section 193 Cr.P.C. It is a case of version and cross-version.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 14.12.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioners have already appeared before the trial Court and have been released on interim bail. They have only to face the trial. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 14.12.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute.
