Petitioner-Dhian Singh alias Dhanna has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.110 dated 07.08.2014, registered at Police Station Barara, District Ambala, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 307, 302, 212 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version,

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the present petitioner has been stated to be armed with a wooden stick. Though, he has been named in the FIR, but has not been named at the time of second occurrence when the murder took place. No injury has been attributed to the present petitioner. Moreover, in the similar circumstances, co-accused, namely, Bhupesh Rana has already been released on regular bail by this Court vide order dated 12.01.2017 passed in CRM-M-37920-2016.

The petitioner has been in custody since 19.03.2015. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and on the ground of parity also, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
