By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in FIR No.36 dated 05.03.2015, registered under Sections 307, 353 and 186 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC') read with Section 34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, Distt. Fazilka.

Contents that except the presence in the vehicle driven by the co-accused, there is nothing against the petitioner to connect with the crime. Allegedly 9 mm pistol and 30 bore pistol have been shown to be recovered from the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 05.03.2015.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel submits that the petitioner is involved in two more FIRs, however, he fairly admits that the

petitioner is on bail in both the cases. He informs that challan has been filed and out of 14 prosecution witnesses, none has been examined so far.

Heard.

Considering the facts that the petitioner in custody since 05.03.2015; challan stands presented; out of 14 prosecution witnesses, none has been examined so far, trial is likely to take a long time, therefore, no purpose would be served in keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court, concerned.
