The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.470 dated 2.8.2016 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 306, 34 IPC, at Police Station Sadar, Bhiwani.

Heard.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the court, Mr.Tanuj Sharma, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court accepts notice and submits that intimation by Registry informing of fixation of the petition has already been received and record of the case is available with him.

Amit son of complainant Raj Bala was married with Bunti daughter of the petitioner and from this marriage, he was having a son. As per the complainant, on 31.7.2016, Amit and Sumit were beaten by the petitioner, his brother and wife. When the complainant intervened,

she was also pushed away. Again on 1.8.2016, they came at 8:00 a.m. And gave beatings to Amit who committed suicide at about 10:00 a.m. In the suicide note left by the deceased, he had named his wife Bunti and her parents for compelling him to commit suicide.

The petitioner was arrested in this case on 3.9.2016. The challan has been presented against him and he is facing trial. He is father-in-law of deceased. Allegation against him is of giving beatings to deceased. Whether this abetted him (the deceased) to commit suicide is a fact to be proved by the prosecution.

Keeping in view the above facts and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Satbir is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Bhiwani subject to following terms:-

- a. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- b. In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh before the trial Court.

c. He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
