FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The allegations against the petitioner in this regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. are that on 17.8.2017, 1 Kg of *charas*, a non-commercial quantity has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is behind the bars from three months and that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future.

The factual scenario is not disputed by the learned State counsel, who had readily acceded to the same but has stoutly opposed the grant of bail to the petitioner on the ground of heinousness of offence.

Keeping in view that the non-commercial quantity has been recovered and in view of the period of incarceration and that the trial

is not likely to be concluded in near future and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
