Learned counsel for the State on instructions from the investigating officer submits that challan in this case has been presented on 09.01.2017 and the parents of the petitioner i.e. accused Balbir Singh and Manjit Kaur have since been acquitted by the trial Court vide judgment dated 14.01.2016 (Annexure P-2).

The grievance of the petitioner is that vide order dated 14.01.2016 (Annexure P-9), his application for permission to go abroad has since been declined. During the pendency of this petition, in view of the order dated 26.10.2016 (Annexure P-4) passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court, his bail bonds were accepted and even the challan has been presented.

The petitioner is a permanent resident of England and keeping in view the fact that his parents have since been acquitted by the trial Court vide judgment dated 14.01.2016 (Annexure P-2), he is granted permission

to go abroad and the trial will proceed through his counsel. If, the trial Court is required his presence, he shall come back and appear before the trial Court.

The trial Court shall take surety of ₹10 lacs from the petitioner and, thereafter, he can go abroad.

The petition is allowed accordingly.
