Wayback on October 27, 2010 following order was passed by
the Hon'ble High Court:

“Heard.

Admit.

Interim orders dated 30.07.2009 is vacated.

*However, the petitioner shall pay the arrears of
electricity charges by way of monthly installments of ₹
50,000/- along with simple interest @ 5% per annum, in
addition to the regular bills.*

*The order dated 26.07.2010 shall also stand
modified accordingly.”*

Mr. Balwinder Singh Sudan, Advocate with Mr. J.K.Vaid, CE,
CGRF, Patiala states that the aforesaid order was not complied with by the
petitioner and as a result of that his electricity connection was disconnected
first temporarily on 22.12.2010 and finally permanently disconnected on

17.1.2011. In other words, the petitioner is not using the electricity. It is further stated that till date respondent-Electricity Board has not taken any steps to recover the amount outstanding against the petitioner. Nobody is present on behalf of the petitioner. It seems that the petitioner is not interested in getting the matter settled by way of compromise before the Lok Adalat.

In the aforesaid circumstances, we consider it appropriate at this stage to order consignment of the case to record-room with liberty to the parties, to get the case revived in accordance with law, if circumstances so exist. This order will not debar the Electricity Board to recover the outstanding amount against the petitioner in accordance with law.
