The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 18 dated 18.02.2017, under Section 459, 34 IPC (Section 394 IPC and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act added later on), registered at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been in custody for over 08 months 29 days and similarly situated co-accused, namely, Harwant Singh, was granted regular bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRM No. M-17741 of 2017 on 23.05.2017, who was in custody for about three months. Learned counsel further contends that this Court vide order dated 24.08.2017 has also granted regular bail to another similarly situated co-accused, namely, Ranbir Singh @ Sonu in CRM No. M-29780 of 2017.

Learned State counsel has filed custody certificate of

the petitioner, which indicates that the petitioner has been in custody for over 08 months and 29 days as on 25.11.2017.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner has been in custody for almost 09 months and similarly situated co-accused have been granted regular bail, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner, namely, Tarun Kumar @ Rambo is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
