The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.152 dated 24.10.2017 under Sections 419, 420, 406 & 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib, Punjab.

Looking to the role played by the petitioner only identifying the borrower, I do not find any purpose would be served in getting the petitioner arrested. However, petitioner shall be released on *ad interim* anticipatory bail in FIR No.152 dated 24.10.2017 registered under Sections 419, 420, 406 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib, Punjab, on furnishing of his bail bonds amounting to ₹10,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. Petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when required and fully cooperate with the

Investigating/Arresting Officer. Petitioner shall abide by the

conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. In case, the police has any grievance in the matter of interrogation, liberty is granted to apply this Court for further orders.
