Counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to surrender before the trial Court on or before 21.07.2017 and move an application for grant of regular bail. He contends that the said application may be directed to be considered and decided at an early date.

In view of the above submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is allowed to be withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to appear before the trial Court on or before 21.07.2017.

In case the petitioner surrenders and moves an application for grant of bail, the same shall be considered and decided within a period of seven days keeping in view the fact that the petitioner asserts that he was arrested on 26.03.2014 in FIR No.216 dated 15.03.2014, Police Station Hanumangarh Town, District Hanumangarh, Rajasthan, in an NDPS case and, therefore, could not appear before the trial Court on 24.02.2014.
