This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.17 dated 12.03.2009, under Sections 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda.

On 19.12.2016, while issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“This petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.17 dated 12.3.2009, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the IPC registered at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.Suman Deep Singh Walia, D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent No.1 -State.

Adjourned to 13.2.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply copy of the petition to the learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Reference is also made to a compromise Annexure P-2 stated to be effected between the parties.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court immediately not later than one week from today and in that event she be admitted to bail on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.

Notice to respondents No.2 to 4 be issued for the date fixed.

Registry to comply with.”

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has furnished a copy of the order dated 22.12.2016, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Bathinda and which would show that the petitioner Manjit Kaur has duly appeared before the trial Court and has been admitted to interim bail upon furnishing requisite bail bonds and surety bonds.

As the petitioner has joined trial proceedings, prayer made in the present petition, is accepted.

The order dated 19.12.2016, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
