By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.759 dated 16.11.2016, registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, Gurgaon (now Guru Gram).

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 15.12.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation. The parties have compromised the matter and a quashing petition has also been filed.

The learned State counsel, on instructions submits that

the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 15.12.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
