Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondents No.3 and 4 to comply with the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C. Prayer has also been made for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that petitioner No.2 has already made a representation dated 05.11.2017 (Annexure P-1) to the respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, and at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to consider the said representation.

On asking of this Court, Mr. M.S. Nagra, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without making any observations on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-1) and to act in accordance with law.
