Petitioners-Lalit and Ashok Kumar have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.415 dated 12.10.2015, registered at Police Station City Gohana, District Sonapat, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and respondent No.2 also appeared through his counsel.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners; learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 and have gone through the record.

During the pendency of this petition, learned counsel for the parties expressed their willingness to settle the dispute amicably and enabling them to do so, the matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Now the report of Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court has been received and as per the same, the parties have settled their dispute amicably.

Today learned counsel for the petitioners has handed over three post-dated cheques bearing Nos.002976, 002977 and 002978 total amounting to ₹54.50 lakhs, to learned counsel for respondent No.2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has also placed on record affidavit of petitioner No.1-Lalit.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has stated that he has no objection, if this petition is accepted.

Keeping in view the compromise effected between the parties, the instant petition is allowed. It is ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.PC.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for respondent No.2 also request that cheque No.009421 dated 30.01.2017, amounting to ₹10,00,000/-, which was deposited with the Registrar General of this Court in compliance of the order dated 30.01.2017

of this Court to show *bona fide* of the petitioners, be released in favour of respondent No.2.

Registrar General of this Court is directed to release the aforesaid cheque in favour of respondent No.2-Jai Singh against proper receipt and identification.
