This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for granting regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 133 dated 12.4.2016 under Sections 304-B and 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Sector 31, District Faridabad, Haryana.

On 1.3.2017, case was adjourned on the request of learned State counsel for examination of the complainant. Learned State counsel on instructions submits that warrants of arrest have been issued for the complainant for 20.5.2017.

After perusing the contents of the evidence on record, it has been found that there is no demand of dowry against the petitioner.

Keeping in view the role of the petitioner in the FIR and considering the fact that trial would take long time to its own conclusion, petitioner be released on regular bail subject to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, Faridabad (Haryana).
