The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in Complaint Case No.162 dated 28.11.2016 titled as Punjab Agricultural Development Bank Ltd., Branch Office Kotkapura Road Sri Muktsar Sahib, Tehsil and District Sri Muktsar Sahib v/s Gurbhinder Singh filed under Section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act 1881.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to give the cheque in question to the extent of Rs.1,81,500/-.

I think there is no point in refusing the relief of anticipatory bail to the petitioner and the following order is passed:-

It is,further prayed that exemption may kindly be granted from filing the certified/typed/photo copies of Annexure P-1 and Annexure P-2 further place on record the true typed/translated/photo copies of the same, in the interest of justice.”
