Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.242 dated 09.08.2017 registered under Sections 323/436 and 506 IPC at Police Station Khol, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the complainant is the wife of the petitioner and there is possibility of rehabilitation as the petitioner has three years old daughter. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 09.08.2017. The investigation is complete and the challan has been filed. It is further submitted that the trial Court has already framed the charges and it will take time to conclude the trial.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Lal Chand has not disputed the aforesaid factual position.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the facts that the petitioner is in custody since 09.08.2017; the fact that the investigation is complete and the challan has been presented; the fact that the petitioner has three years old daughter and the fact that there are chances of amicable settlement between the parties for the purpose of rehabilitation, the

present petition is allowed. The petitioner – Sunil Kumar is directed to be released on bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Rewari.

The present petition stands disposed of.
