Counsel for parties are ad idem that dispute between the parties has been settled vide settlement/agreement dated 03.05.2017 with the intervention of the mediator in the Mediation and Conciliation Center of this Court. Counsel for the petitioner would submit that in pursuance of the compromise, petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act has already been filed. Statements of the parties in first motion have been recorded and the proceedings have been adjourned for a period of six months in November, 2017.

In view of the above, interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 15.12.2016 is made absolute subject to the following

conditions:-

(i) He shall join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer.

(ii) He shall not offer any threat, promise or inducement to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing the same to the Investigating Officer/Court; and

(iii) He shall not leave the limits of this country without prior permission of the Court.

However, the parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of settlement/agreement dated 03.05.2017.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
