The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 133 dated 03.11.2016 registered for offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 148 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC'), at Police Station Sadar, Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib. (Offence punishable under Section 326 IPC was added later on).

Heard.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioners have joined the investigation and grievous injuries on the person of complainant was attributed to Gurdhian Singh son of Shamsher Singh (non-applicant). Earlier also petitioners have joined the investigation but later on offence punishable under Section 326 IPC was added in FIR.

As per complainant, he had suffered five injuries out of which one was declared grievous, which has been attributed to Gurdhian Singh son of Shamsher Singh.

Keeping in view above facts but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and order dated 16.12.2016 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against them so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that petitioners shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.
- (iv) that petitioners will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
