ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.141 dated 26.08.2017 under Sections 307, 324, 336, 341, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran, on the basis of compromise dated 07.10.2017 (Annexure P-3), which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is outcome of a sudden fight between the students. The injured have fully recovered from their injuries and the matter has been compromised with the intervention of the respectables.

This Court by the order dated 20.11.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of SDJM,

Patti, dated 08.12.2017 has been received, wherein it is stated

that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is outcome of a sudden fight between the students. The injured have fully recovered from their injuries and the matter has been compromised with the intervention of the respectables.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466***, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.141 dated 26.08.2017 under Sections 307, 324, 336, 341, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner(s).
