Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner-Rakesh Kumar @ Rinku in case registered by way of FIR No.133 dated 21st March, 2016 at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra under Sections 279, 336, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC and Section 61 of Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of orders of interim bail dated 11th January, 2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State Counsel on instructions from S.I. Gulab Singh, Police Station CIA-2, Kurukshetra who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 11th January, 2017 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner(s) will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
