The instant petition has been preferred under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 40 dated 25.06.2011 and Sections 420, 120-B I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Bareta, District Mansa.

Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioner having been initially arrested, was granted concession of regular bail. However, he absented from the trial proceedings and as such, his bail bonds were canceled/forfeited.

The petitioner thereafter approached the court seeking concession of anticipatory bail on the ground that on the date in question i.e. 30.07.2016 he had been admitted to hospital on account of having suffered an accident. However, such prayer for anticipatory bail did not find favour and the application was dismissed on 21.10.2016.

It has gone uncontroverted that thereafter petitioner chose not to surrender. Accordingly, proclamation proceedings were initiated and the petitioner already stands declared as a Proclaimed Offender.

The conduct of the petitioner disentitles him from the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition is dismissed.
