Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.164 dated 22.05.2017 under Sections 148/149/323/506 of IPC, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Beri, District Jhajjar.

Though on 21.11.2017 when notice of motion was issued in the case, it was contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR and no injury has been attributed to him, however, learned State counsel has submitted that the complainant has specifically named the petitioner i.e. Neeraj (Katya). The petitioner was having gun and when the complainant tried to stop, the petitioner started abusing him and he (petitioner) along with his friends started beating the complainant with stick. He has further

submitted that there are 11 more cases registered against the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has not only been specifically named, rather he is involved in as many as 11 other cases which are otherwise of serious nature, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
