Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.80 dated 12.08.2017 under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon order dated 31.10.2017 passed by this Court in CRM-M-40029-2017 titled as 'Prem Singh alias Gaggi Versus State of Punjab', whereby the co-accused of the petitioner has been admitted on bail.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate of the petitioner in court today, which is taken on record. As per custody certificate, petitioner is in custody for the last 3 months and 11 days as

on 27.11.2017. He does not dispute the fact that the co-accused of the

petitioner, namely, Prem Singh alias Gaggi has been admitted on bail by this Court.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 13.08.2017 and FSL report is still awaited, coupled with the fact that the co-accused of the petitioner has been admitted on bail by this Court, petitioner is admitted on bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is indulged in any such cases again, the prosecution shall be at liberty to seek cancellation of his bail.
