In view of the fact that the petitioner has paid back the entire amount to the complainant, therefore, the petitioner is entitled to grant of bail subject to her filing of an undertaking on affidavit to be filed before the trial Court that he would not indulge in similar or any other kind of offences in future. The petitioner-Malkiat Kaur Punia @ Sunny @ Shanky being a woman is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Learned counsel for the State submits that there are 33 cases to the credit of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been acquitted in all but for two cases.

Liberty is reserved in favour of the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail, if the petitioner indulges in any other offence.
