It is submitted that the petitioner had been regularly appearing in the Criminal Complaint No. 59 dated 10.10.2013, titled as 'Ravinder Kaur Vs. Talwinder Singh and others', under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148, 149, 354-A, 354-B IPC. However, he failed to appear before the learned trial Court on 25.11.2016, as it is submitted that talks of compromise were in progress. His application for exemption from personal appearance was dismissed on 25.11.2016. It is to be noted that thereafter the petitioner moved an application for anticipatory bail before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib in September, 2017, which has been dismissed vide impugned order dated 25.09.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, states that he does not press this petition for the relief of anticipatory bail. It is however, submitted that the petitioner shall surrender before the learned trial Court within one week. The learned trial Court be directed to decide his application for bail pending trial, expeditiously.

Dismissed as not pressed. However, in case, the petitioner surrenders before the learned trial Court within one week from today, his application for bail pending trial, if any, be decided expeditiously in accordance with law, preferably within one week.
