Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.193 dated 27.09.2017, under Sections 399, 402, 379, 411 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Beas, Amritsar, District Amritsar. This Court had made an order dated 21.11.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
