The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of FIR No.448 dated 15.9.2017, under Section 174-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Ballabgarh Sadar, District Faridabad.

The petitioner who is arrayed as an accused in a complaint case under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, was declared a proclaimed offender resulting in registration of the aforesaid FIR.

Vide order dated 21.11.2017, the petitioner was directed to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation. Today, learned State counsel assisted by ASI Pardeep Singh has stated that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required.

In view of the aforesaid position, the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 21.11.2017 are hereby made absolute.

The petition stands accepted accordingly.
