Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.24, dated 12.03.2015, under Sections 21/22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar Rural.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is 150 grams of contraband.

As per report of the Chemical Examiner, the same has been found to be containing alprazolam. Such recovery would be construed as commercial quantity.

This Court as such would not be inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner benefit of regular bail in the light of the specific bar envisaged under Section 37 of the NDPS Act.

Petition is dismissed.
