Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.204 dated 16.11.2016 under Sections 420, 409 IPC and Sections 7, 9 and 10 of Essential Commodities Act, 1955, registered at Police Station Bahin, District Palwal.

This Court vide order dated 17.12.2016 had granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to joining the investigation. Though the petitioner joined the investigation, but he was not cooperating with the investigating agency. Therefore, vide orders dated 16.02.2017, 27.03.2017, 23.05.2017 and 30.08.2017, petitioner was again directed to join and cooperate with the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to orders dated 17.12.2016, 16.02.2017, 27.03.2017, 23.05.2017 and 30.08.2017, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Suresh Kumar, has stated that in terms of above orders, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide orders dated 17.12.2016, 16.02.2017, 27.03.2017, 23.05.2017 and 30.08.2017 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
