It is submitted that petitioner No.1 – Kanchan Gupta aged about 26 years has got married with petitioner No.2 – Jatinder Kumar aged about 27 years against wishes of father of petitioner No.1 Kanchan Gupta arrayed as respondent No.4, who is threatening to interfere in their marital life.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 – SSP, SAS Nagar, Mohali, to look into the representation (**Annexure P-5**) submitted by the petitioners and to take necessary steps to ensure that lives and liberty of the petitioners are not jeopardized at the hands of respondent No.4 or persons claiming under him. However, this direction will not validate the marriage said to have taken place between the petitioners and will have no effect on any civil or criminal action which could be initiated in the matter in accordance with law.
