Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.102, dated 19.12.2015, registered under Sections 302 and 34 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Rajpura, District Patiala.

At the very outset, learned State counsel submits that the entire prosecution evidence has been led and at this fag end of the trial, the petitioner be not admitted to regular bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the fact that the entire prosecution witnesses have been examined.

In view of the above, at this stage, I am not inclined to grant regular bail to the petitioner. However, to meet the ends of justice, the trial Court is directed to take the final decision in the trial expeditiously, of course, subject to the cooperation by the accused.
