This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.38 dated 15.5.2013 under sections 302, 449, 201, 120-B, 148, 149 I.P.C and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station, Tapa, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the complaint of Jagroop Singh in relation to an occurrence that took place on 15.5.2013 and in which his son Resham Singh succumbed and lost his life on account of fire arm injuries having been sustained.

The fire arm injuries are specifically attributed to Balwant Singh @ Babbu, Kulwinder Singh @ Kinda and Ranjit Singh.

In so far as the present petitioner is concerned, the allegation is with regard to having hatched a conspiracy with Tarsem Singh @ Sama to facilitate the killing of Resham Singh.

Present petitioner has been implicated on the strength of Section 120-B I.P.C.

Even as per complainant's version no overt act/injury on the person of Resham Singh is attributed to the present petitioner.

Petitioner has faced incarceration since 21.5.2013.

Learned State counsel would apprise the Court that out of 49 prosecution witnesses cited none has been examined till date.

Co-accused Balwant Singh, Kulwinder Singh and Ranjit Singh have been granted benefit of bail by this Court in the light of order carrying even date i.e. 16.3.2017 passed in CRM No. M-42693 of 2016 and CRM No. M-42476 of 2016.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Barnala.

Petition disposed of.
