Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.289 dated 06.06.2017 under Sections 323/324/34/506 and 307 IPC, registered at Police Station Rai, District Sonipat.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he had caught hold of hands of the complainant, whereas the other co-accused, namely, Ravi had caused injuries on the chest and stomach of the injured with bodkin (ice *sua*). Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the injuries had been caused by Ravi and not by the petitioner. Petitioner is in custody since 11.08.2017.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surender Kumar, does not dispute the custody. However, he states that

since the petitioner had caught hold of hands of the complainant, it facilitated the co-accused to inflict injuries upon the complainant. He does not deserve the concession of regular bail.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Though initially the case was registered under Sections 323/324/34/506 IPC and it is only on 11.08.2017, the offence under Section 307 IPC was added. Otherwise the petitioner remained on bail.

Since the injuries inflicted on the person of the complainant have not been attributed to the petitioner and the only role attributed to the petitioner is that he had caught hold of hands of the complainant, he is admitted on bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Accordingly, present petition stands disposed of.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall not pressurize the complainant or any of the prosecution witnesses in any manner directly or indirectly and in case it is found that he is making any such effort, his bail shall be liable to be cancelled.
