This petition for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner has been filed in criminal case bearing FIR No.96 dated 06.07.2016, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the IPC and under Sections 43, 65, 66 of the IT Act, Police Station Maksoodan, District Jalandhar.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that co-accused of the present petitioner namely Gagandeep Singh, Sat Parkash @ Sunny Chadha and Jasbir Singh had already been granted the benefit of regular bail in this case by this Court vide order dated 12.12.2016 (Annexure P-3). It is further contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that case of the present petitioner is on same footing as that of his said co-

accused. Then as per record the petitioner was arrested in this case on 06.07.2016 and challan has already been presented in this case before the learned trial Court.

Conclusion of trial will take long time, hence no useful purpose will be served by keeping him behind the bars any more. Therefore, in view of the abovesaid circumstances, this petition is accepted. Petitioner-Amritpal Singh be admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court / Duty Magistrate, Jalandhar.

This petition stands disposed of accordingly.
