Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr. P. C., the petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.108, dated 09.07.2016, registered under Sections 25,27,54,59 of Arms Act at Police Station Sector 11, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 09.07.2016; during course of trial the injured has turned hostile; out of 14 prosecution witnesses only one witness has been examined and as such the trial is likely to take a long time to conclude.

Learned State counsel has not controverted the above facts.

In view of the above, I am of the considered opinion that petitioner deserves the concession of regular bail.
