Vide report dated 14.02.2017, Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kapurthala has noticed that respondents Manpreet Singh and his mother Surinder Kaur had not appeared on 18.01.2017 and 19.01.2017 despite repeated notices issued to them. The Magistrate has found that the validity and genuineness of the compromise in question could not be determined in view of aforesaid fact.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bakshish Singh submits that the offences under Sections 452 and 325 IPC have already been deleted from the case. None appeared on behalf of the petitioners consecutively for two dates.

In view of above, no indulgence can be granted to the petitioners for quashing the FIR on the basis of compromise as the parties have not complied with the directions issued on 17.12.2016 by this Court.
